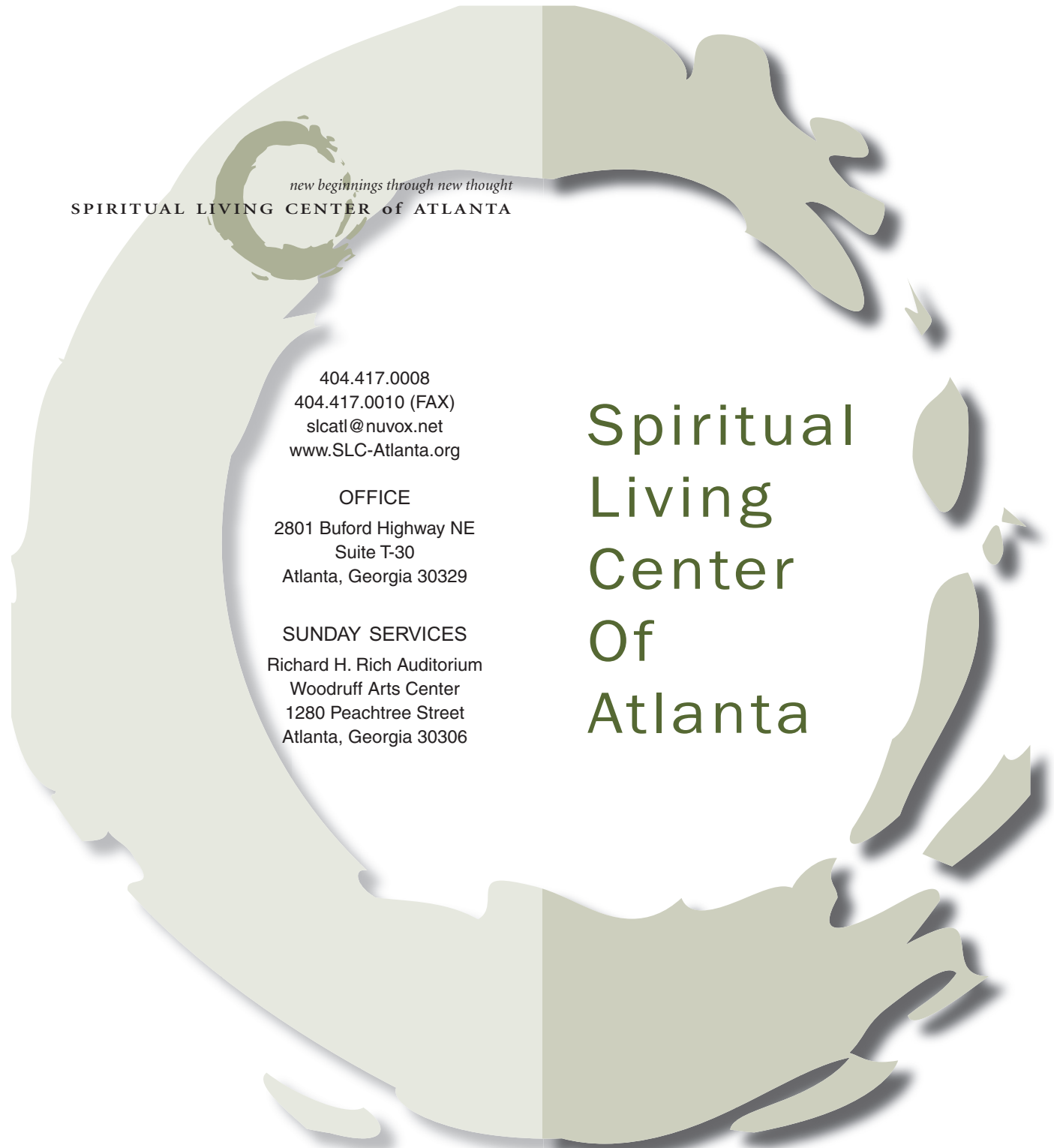

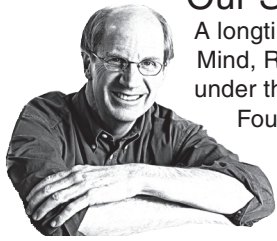

Youth Program

Our Youth Program, for children four years old and older, meets each week during the 11:15 service. The purpose of this program is to teach children what it means to be created in the image and likeness of God. Through stories, games and activities, children learn to recognize themselves as unique and valuable expressions of God and they learn to use the power of mind and heart to create good experiences in their lives. Nursery is available for children under the age of four.

Teen Program

In our Teen Program, students learn ideas that help them not only survive but THRIVE in the teen years. Each Sunday during the 11:15 service, teens learn to work with the principles of Science of Mind so they can have more of what they want in life and less of what they don't want.

Community Groups

Our Church sponsors a variety of community activities to encourage fellowship among our friends and members with common interests. Volunteer Opportunities

Our volunteer teams are the heart and hands of the church, serving in the Bookstore, ushering, audio engineering, hospitality, the Youth Programs, Sunday setup / breakdown, office clerical help and community event planning.

Ongoing Spiritual Development

Throughout most of the year the Spiritual Living Center of Atlanta offers accredited classes in personal spiritual development using the principles of the Science of Mind as developed by Dr. Ernest Holmes and supported by a number of other great spiritual thinkers, teachers and writers.

Under the heading **SOM 100** and **SOM 200**, we offer classes which address the personal spiritual development of the student in different but spiritually consistent ways. These classes are open to all, with no prerequisite. A certificate of completion is granted by Religious Science International for both SOM 100 and SOM 200 when successfully completed.

Under the heading **SOM 300**, we offer a 32- class course of instruction in consciousness healing to students who hold certificates of completion for both SOM 100 and SOM 200. This is an intensive class requiring full participation by each student. Enrollment is by invitation of the Senior Minister. Religious Science International will award a certificate of completion upon successful completion of SOM 300.

Other Classes, Seminars and Workshops are presented through the year and are announced in our newsletter, in our classes and at our Sunday services.

Questions and Answers about the Spiritual Living Center of Atlanta

Does the church adhere to a doctrine or observe any rules or sacraments?

NO. Religious Science states that there is perfect order in the Universe and that the Universe is governed by a perfect Principle, which operates through every individual at his or her own level of consciousness. Since this Principle is universal, it cannot be summed up in a creed, and does not require any particular form of worship.

Is Religious Science a Christian Religion?

Religious Science draws upon the basic truths found at the heart of all religions. We respect and teach from all the great World Truths and Teachers.

Are there any membership dues, or will I be required to make a financial pledge if I join the church?

NO. Although the church depends upon the regular financial support of its members, we believe this support must be voluntary and consistent with each member's idea of what he or she is able to give and feels right about giving. We are entirely self-supporting.
